Before travel

1. Do not travel to your booked Holiday Cottage Otterburn-Melvaig
2. If guest has or suspects they have COVID they will not be permitted to enter property.

Symptoms develop at property

According to UK Hospitality guidelines in Scotland, if a guest presents themselves with symptoms or Covid-19 or is asymptomatic but declares the need to self-isolate, they should be advised to check out and return home to self-isolate according to current government guidance. If the guest has acute symptoms, has breathing difficulties, or their life is at potential risk, seek medical help immediately.
